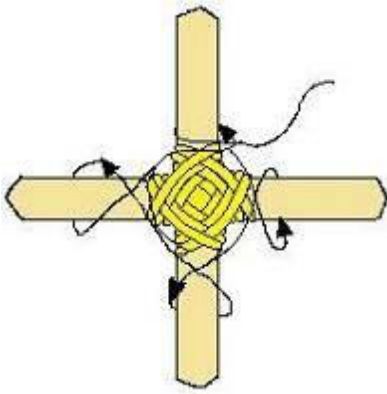


Ojo de Dios - Mexican Gods Eye



Ojo de Dios means "eye of God" in Spanish.

The Mexican Indians made them for good luck pieces.

Cross 2 ice-cream sticks (you can glue them together if you find it easier to hold). Use coloured wool to tie the sticks together by making a knot around the sticks where they cross. Weave the wool over one stick, then around & under, then over the stick toward the next stick. Do this on each stick. Continue around the square doing the same thing for all the rows.

You can change colours whenever you'd like to. Start a new colour by tying the new piece of wool to the previous coloured wool.
